## **World Food Consequences of the War on Ukraine**

On August 2, 2022, up-to-the-minute data and forecasts about the agricultural situation and outlook for Ukraine, world grain and oilseed markets, and international food and famine situations will be presented by three expert teams at the annual meetings of the Agricultural & Applied Economics Association (AAEA).

Dr. Oleg Nivievskyi, of the Ukrainian <u>Center for Food and Land Use Research (C4FLUR)</u> at the Kiev School of Economics will present <u>the latest agricultural situation and outlook for Ukraine</u> in a presentation titled "Beyond survival: farming chronicles, outlook and strategies for Ukrainian agriculture following the 2022 Russian Invasion" co-authored with Dr. Mariia Bogonos who leads the C4FLUR team, and Litvinov Valentyn, Martyshev Pavlo, Neyter Roman, Igor Piddubnyi and Hryhorii Stolnikovych.

Dr. David Laborde of the <u>International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI)</u> will present the latest outlook for world grain and oilseed availability, trade, and prices; as well as food insecurity. The presentation "The Impact of the Ukraine Crisis on Global Food Security" presented by <u>Dr. Laborde</u>, is co-authored with <u>Dr. Joseph W. Glauber</u>, former Chief Economist at USDA.

<u>Catherine Bertini</u>, former Executive Director of the <u>United Nations' World Food Programme</u>, will present the <u>latest information about food shortages</u>, famines, the international response, and <u>policy</u> in "Global food security consequences of the war in Ukraine- A collateral damage of mega proportions?" co-authored by <u>Dr. Arif Husain</u>, Chief Economist at the WFP.

The Invited Paper session "World Food Consequences of the War on Ukraine" is organized and financed by AAEA members in the <u>National Center for Food and Agricultural Policy</u> with support from the AAEA and the <u>AAEA Senior Section</u>.
